

## **Desert Discovery Tours - Al Areesh Camp - Wahibah Sands**

### **General Information**

- In the main reception / majlis there is complimentary coffee tea & water
- In the afternoon & evenings there is a cooler box with canned drinks, which are also free.
- Dune driving will start approx 1 hour before sunset, & again early morning, upon request
- The evening meal is served at about 7.00 p.m. which is, subject to availability, followed by Bedouin singers & dancers from the villages surrounding this camp
- Sheisha / hubbly -bubbly is available, at OMR 1, payment directly to the staff
- There is electrical lighting and 3 pin power points throughout the camp.
- The generator is usually turned off at about 11.00 pm – 12:00 midnight. Torches are available for your use.
- The chalets lock, from the inside, but neither the chalets or tents lock from the outside. If you have any valuables we suggest you keep them with you, or in your vehicle.
- The main camp gates are locked at midnight and opened again at sunrise.
- Breakfast is served from 7.00 a.m.
- Use of the skiing and sand boarding equipment is free. There is however a nominal charge if you want to be driven to the top of the larger dune ranges. (We recommend that children under 12 are supervised by their parents)
- Desert Discovery Tours encourages support of the local community. We are pleased to provide the location for the Bedouin ladies to sell their handicrafts, and for the camel owners to provide rides. They are both at Al Areesh from approximately 7.00 to about 9:30, and payment is directly to them (Please note: When you take the rides you will be properly supervised, by the camel owners, but do so at your own risk)
- All water is bought to the camp by tanker, so all efforts to reduce water usage are greatly appreciated.
